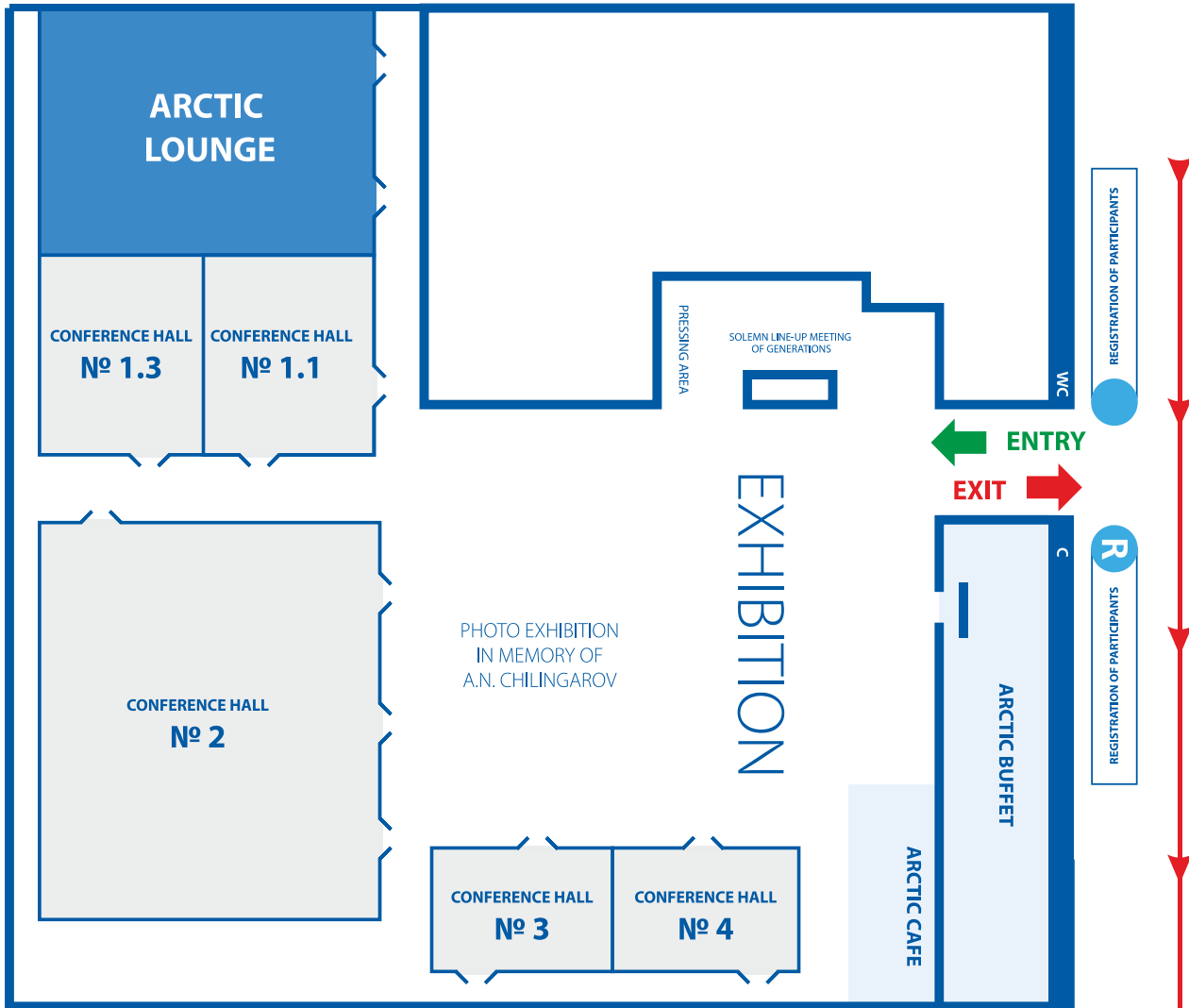

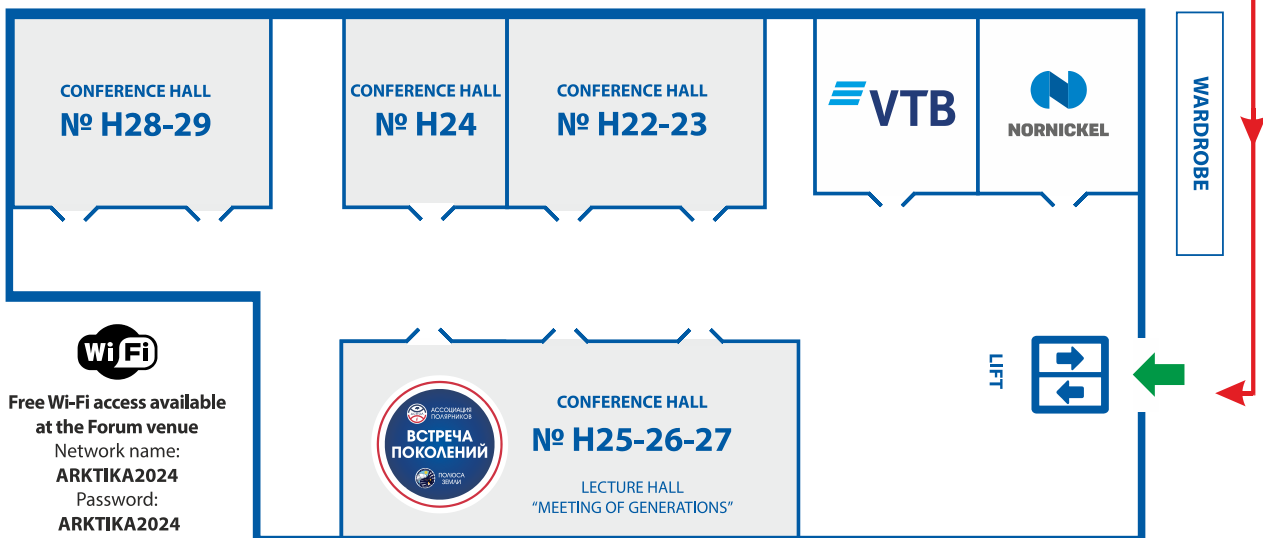

PLENARY SESSION

The President V.V. Putin signed a decree on May 7, 2024 on the national development goals of Russia up to 2030 and in the perspective up to 2036, national projects have been defined. The goal is to increase prosperity and quality of life. At the same time, the Arctic requires special approaches as a macro-region with unique economic, social, regulatory, climatic and logistical features. The key state fundamental documents and programs defining the strategic development of the AZRF and the Northern Sea Route were developed before entering a period of economic and geopolitical challenges. The first stage of the AZRF Development Strategy implementation is coming to an end.

The new conditions determine the need for assessment, elaboration of additional measures and a targeted approach to the needs of each individual.

How to achieve national development goals taking into account the uniqueness of the Arctic? What mechanisms are needed for their realization? What has been accomplished within the framework of the Strategy for the Development of the AZRF and what measures need to be finalized? Do Arctic state programs need to be updated in connection with new challenges, and how exactly?

How can the new documents provide for the risks of the future? What tasks and opportunities do the authorities, the business community, public and scientific organizations have in ensuring the social and economic development of the Arctic in the present and future?

Like the Arctic as a whole, each of the regions of the ASRF has unique socio-economic, resource and natural potential, and an individual approach to each entity is necessary to unlock all the opportunities.

Reference localities have been identified. A new strategic planning tool has appeared - a master plan developed with the opinion of residents in mind.

The Arctic mortgage is in effect. A unified subsidy is in operation. The number of users of the Hectar program is growing. The world's largest Special Economic Zone attracts more and more investors.

But the task is to stay ahead of the challenges of time and create new mechanisms to continue the development of each region in a rapidly changing environment.

What has already been done and what remains to be done? What public policy tools do the regions need to achieve their master planning goals? How to include the remaining localities and intensify their development? What financial mechanisms are required to implement infrastructure projects?
